

## Operating Procedure In-Camera Meetings

At meetings of the Committee of the Whole, on occasion, there is a need to convene outside of the public meeting.

The Education Act is clear about the public's access and only certain agenda items are permitted to be held in-camera. These items are normally to protect the rights of individuals, or to protect the legal rights of the Board (*R.S.O.1990, c.E.2,s.207(2)*).

The Senior Administration team, management staff, and other management representation are permitted in the room for the in-camera session unless the items discussed reflect on the personal interests of the member. The decision is at the discretion of the Chair of the Board or the Director of Education.

All items discussed in-camera may not be disclosed to the public.
